NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Appendix D will apply including D2.
- 1.3 No national authority prescriptions will apply
- 1.4 Racing rules will be changed as follows:
 - Part 4 Preamble and Rule 40 is changed, so that competitors shall wear personal floatation devices at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing clothing.
 - Rule 60 is changed as follows:
Competitors shall comply with the ISAF Betting and Anti-Corruption Code (Appendix 5 of the ISAF Regulations). An alleged or actual breach of this rule shall be dealt with under the Code. It shall not be grounds for a protest and rule 63.1 does not apply. This changes rule 60.

The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.

- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. FORMAT

- 3.1 The championship will be a four boat against four boat team race. For teams having five competitors, any four may compete in a race, provided that the fifth competitor remains in the area designated for coaches or ashore from the warning signal of that race until that race has been completed and is not allowed to assist the team.

4. ELEGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 Teams may be made up of:

Girls (same nation or different nations), Boys (same nation or different nations), Girls and Boys mixed (same nation or different nations). All competitors shall be under the age of 20 on 31 December 2016.

- 4.2 All teams compete in one series.
- 4.3 A competitor may only enter and race in one team.
- 4.4 All competitors must be members of a sailing club under an ISAF-MNA.
- 4.5 Eligible teams must enter online via www.booss.se. Entry “Zoom8 Team Racing European Championship 8-9. October 2016”. Entries must be made not later than 25 of September 2016.
- 4.6 The entry fee is EUR 265 per team and shall be transferred not later than 25 of September 2016.
The entry fee includes the ‘Get together dinner’ on Saturday evening for the sailors and shall be transferred in EURO to the following account:

- 4.7 Late entry will be accepted at an additional fee of EUR 40 to be paid in cash at registration.
- 4.8 No entry is complete until it has been accepted by the Organizing Authority, and a team is not registered before the regatta fee is paid in full.
- 4.9 Each participating team shall be successfully registered before the first warning signal in the regatta.

- 5.2 Time and place of coach/team leader meeting will be posted on the Official Notice Board.
- 5.3 On Sunday 9 October no warning signal will be made after 15:30

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

7. VENUE

7.1 The racing areas will be just outside the harbour of Boo Segelsällskap.

8. THE COURSE

9. SAFETY

All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices. Wet suit or dry suit is mandatory.

10. SUPPORT BOATS

10.1 Support boats are requested to register in the race office, including which dinghies to who is an affiliation. Registration must be completed before the first warning signal. The support boats shall fly the burgee of their club or their nation flag or a white flag with National Letters as described in Appendix G.

10.2 The sailing instructions will include further instructions for the support boats.

11. BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

13. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded as follows:

For the top three teams: Gold, silver and bronze medals.

The Organizing Authority may award further prizes.

14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of EUR 1.500.000 per event or the equivalent. A boat shall upon a request produce a valid insurance certificate. If a competitor cannot produce a valid certificate he or she will be excluded from participation.
